## NEW TRANSLATION OF MASS READINGS

From Advent 2024 the Bishops of England & Wales require all parishes to use a new translation of the readings at Mass. The parish will have to purchase a new set of books of the readings known as the Lectionary and a new Book of the Gospels. The new Lectionary will be in 4 Volumes. The cost of each volume is £150. The cost of the Book of the Gospels is £335. If anyone would wish to buy a volume of the Lectionary or the Book of the Gospels, then a dedication can be included in whichever item you give the donation for. Otherwise, any donation you make, however, big or small will be greatly appreciated. Don't forget to gift aid any donation.
