A BUILDINGS UPDATE from your Parish Finance Committee

You may have noticed that work has been done on our fire exits and other doors. This is in response to a recent risk assessment which the Diocese commissioned to help bring the parishes up to current standards. Work will also start in November on substantially improving our outside lighting along with providing some internal emergency lighting. Our main steps are in desperate need of refurbishing to make them safe and welcoming and, depending on the weather, this work will be done in November or in the Spring. We are continuing to work on securing funding towards replacement of our ageing flat roof - hopefully in the Spring 2025.

Of course all of this comes at significant cost and we take great care to secure the best value with our contractors, with much of the non-specialist work being done by volunteers. We are most grateful for contributions, however small, to our Building Restoration Fund, either by contactless payment, cash or cheque (please mark these 'Building Restoration').
