#### DEANERY CLERGY MEETING WITH BISHOP RICHARD

The clergy of the Worthing Deanery, priests and deacons met with Bishop Richard. He led a conversation about how the Worthing Deanery will move to being one new parish. The key points are that we will move at a reasonable pace once the new priest, Fr Irek arrives in the deanery to replace Fr Terry who is moving to Eastbourne. He comes before Holy Week. The focus will initially be on enabling the clergy of the deanery to work together better, then ensuring the laity participate in the process, and better communication. It is likely to be about 12 months before we become this new parish. It's important to note that the priests and deacons will remain in their current communities but try to collaborate better, working together using their strengths and skills. As far as St Michael's is concerned we remain an important resource for the new bigger parish with our excellent facilities. Because of this the Diocese is continuing to enable us to improve our building including extensive roof repairs.
